In order to enable access to McGraw-Hill Campus, you must complete the following one-time setup process to add and configure the module in your Desire2Learn course.

1. Log in to your institution's Desire2Learn site and navigate to your course.

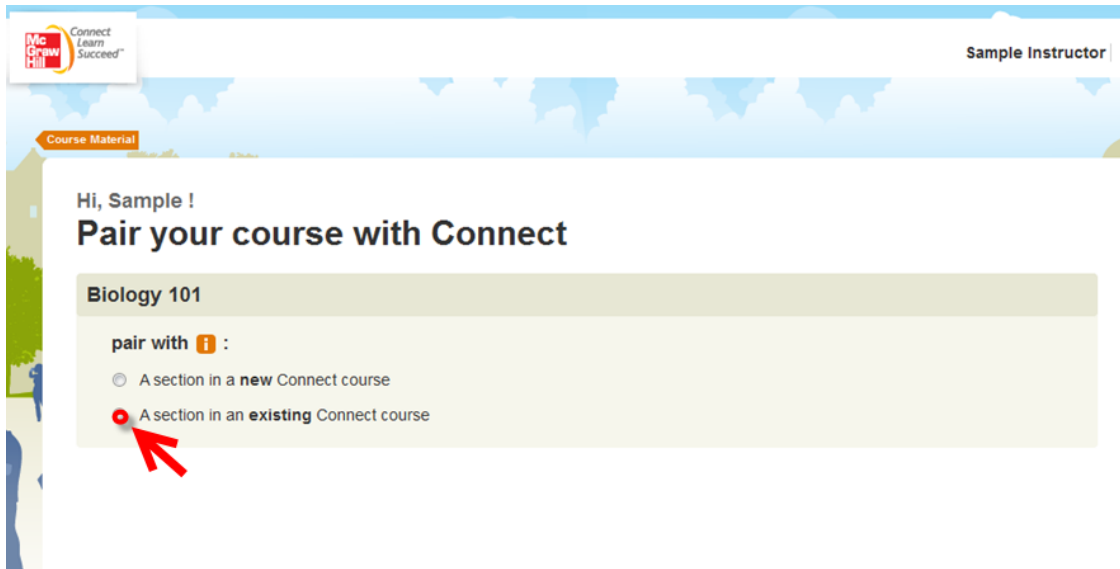
1. To give your students access to your course in Connect click “I want this for my students” at the top right hand corner of the page.



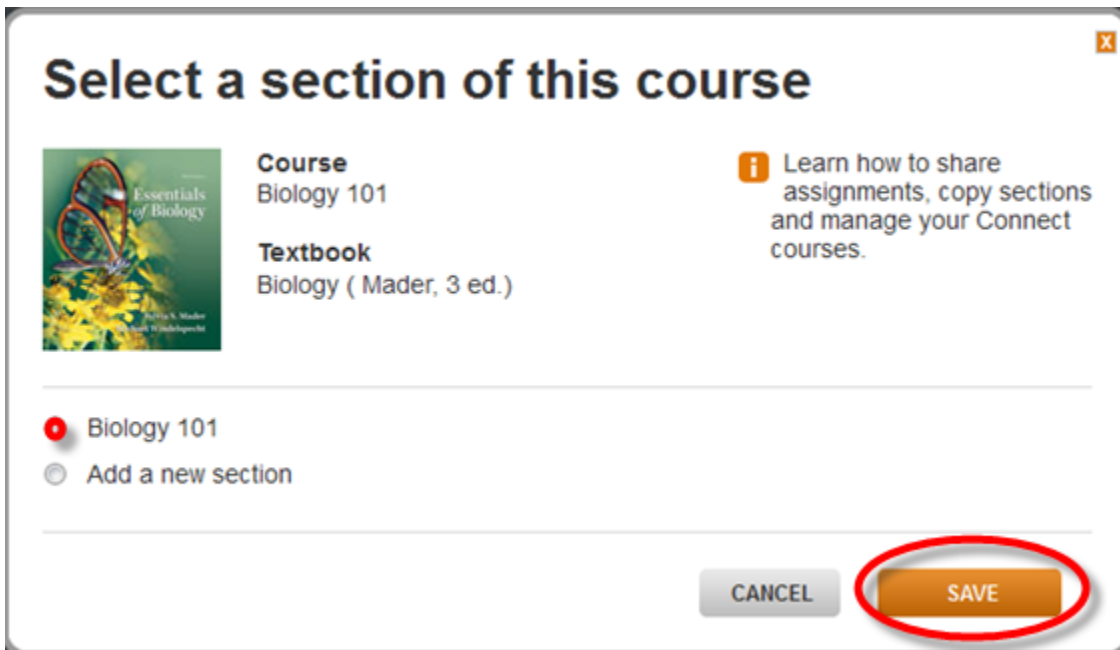
2. You will see a pop-up screen that details the options your students will have to purchase access to Connect. Click the Adopt Connect button.

4. Choose your course and click "Save."






