


Trend of ROE








Trend of DE Ratio




Trend of Divident Payout Ratio






Trend of Average Collection Period




Indian Paper Industry - Trends in Net Income to Total Assets



Indian Paper Industry - Trends in CURRENT RATIO



INDIAN PAPER INDUSTRY - QUICK RATIO




Income Statement: Common Size Analysis








Balance Sheet - Assets: Common Size Analysis





Balance Sheet - Liabilities: Common Size Analysis








Trend Analysis of Monsanto India Limited
