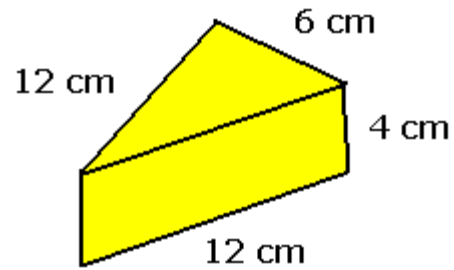
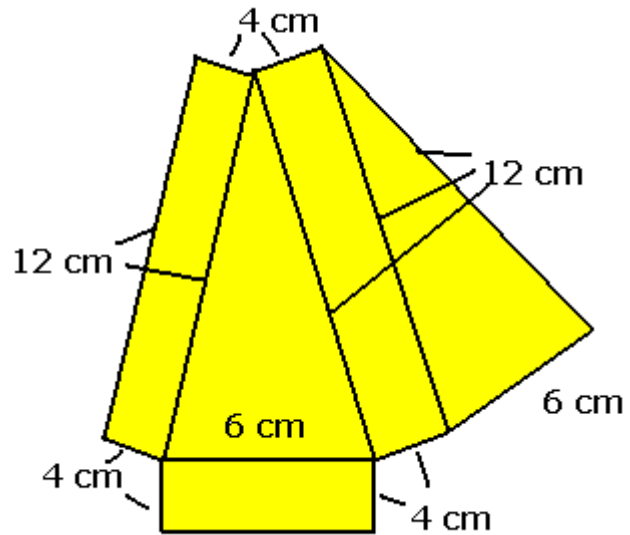


MATC9 Ch03.4 Key Concepts 4 Nets for Solid Shapes Worked Example

Example: Sketch a net for a wedge of cheese as shown.



Solution: Start with a triangle for the base. Then, add rectangles for the sides. Finally, add a triangle for the top.

1. Sketch a net for a pup tent with a base width of 2 m, a height of 1.5 m, and a length of 1.8 m.

2. Sketch a net for a steel splitting wedge 5 cm high, forming an isosceles triangle, as shown.
