
1. Viewing DWF Files

Launch your browser and link to the sites listed below. Use the browser to view sample DWF files.

2. Creating a DWF

Open the **FRAMPLN** drawing from the Chapter 33 Exercises. Select the *Model Tab*. *Freeze* the **DIM2** layer, then *Zoom Extents*. *SaveAs* **CE43EX2**. Use the *Plot* command to create an *ePlot* file called **FRAMPLN.DWF**. Open the .DWF file by launching your browser and using the *Open* command under the *File* pull-down menu.



3. Using Hyperlink

Open the **FRAMEPLN** drawing from the Chapter 33 Exercises. Select the *Model Tab* and *Zoom Extents*. Draw a *Rectangle* and then use *Mtext* to create text that indicates "Click Here to View Section" as shown in Figure CE45-1. Use the *Hyperlink* command to link to the .DWF file you will create in the next step, for example "frame.dwf." (The path you enter may vary depending on your working directory.) Use *SaveAs* to name the drawing **FPLN**. Use the *Plot* command to create an *ePlot* named **FPLAN.DWF**.

Follow the same procedure with the **FRAMING** drawing, except use text indicating "Click Here for Plan View" (see Figure CE45-2). *SaveAs* **FRAME**. Use *Hyperlink* to link to "fplan.dwf." Create the **FRAME.DWF** file using *ePlot*.

Finally, launch your browser and *Open* the **FPLAN.DWF** file. Switch back and forth between the two drawings by clicking the pointer in the area indicated on the drawing.



4. Add URL Links to Detail Drawings

From the **FRAMEPLN** drawing and the **FRAMING** drawing, create detail view drawings (of the pier blocks or the connection details of the beams) by using *Wblock*. Name the new drawings **FPLAN-DET** and **FRAME-DET**. Add appropriate text in each new drawing to view the "Full Section View" and "Full Plan View." Use *Hyperlink* to link these two files to the drawings in Exercise 3 by assigning the appropriate URLs to reference the other drawings. Next, create an additional link on each of the drawings in Exercise 3 to view the new detail drawings. Finally, create new .DWF files for each of the four drawings. When you are finished, launch your browser; you should be able to view all four drawings by these links.
