## PART 1: EXPLORING PEACHTREE COMPLETE ACCOUNTING 2005

Part 1 shows your students how to get started using Peachtree Complete Accounting 2005 (PCA). The students learn about the basic features of PCA. The aim of Part 1 is to provide software familiarity rather than to test accounting knowledge. The sample companies, Bellwether Garden Supply and Stone Arbor Landscaping, are used for this purpose. The sample companies have prestored transactions that demonstrate the features of the software. Bellwether Garden Supply and Stone Arbor Landscaping are not intended to teach these features in depth. Computer accounting skills, setting up companies from scratch, and completing the accounting cycle are shown in Chapters 9–18 and Projects 1, 1A, 2, 2A, 3, 4 and 4A.

Part 2 covers service businesses and the use of the Cash Disbursements Journal, Cash Receipts Journal, General Journal for adjusting entries, and General Ledger. Part 3 shows your students how to use Peachtree's Accounts Payable and Accounts Receivable subsidiary systems for merchandising businesses. Part 4 explains Peachtree's advanced features: customizing forms, import/export, using Excel and Word with Peachtree, and dynamic data exchange.

At the end of Part 2, there are two comprehensive projects: Sharon Watson, MD, and a Student-Designed Service Business. At the end of Part 3, there are two comprehensive projects: Sports Shoppe and a Student-Designed Merchandising Business. At the end of the Part 4, there are three comprehensive projects: Verde Computer Club; RBW Manufacturing, Inc.; and a Student-Designed Project.

Throughout the textbook key terms are **boldfaced** and **italicized**. This indicates words that are defined in the Glossary, which is available on the textbook's website at <a href="https://www.mhhe.com/yacht2005">www.mhhe.com/yacht2005</a>.
