SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS

3.4 DOUBLE-TRUCK TOPICS

BACKGROUND: All communities have their issues. Parents at a small charter school might be concerned about the impact of state testing on their students' ability to attend college. Citizens in a larger community might be concerned about the increasing cost of road repair and highway construction. Special groups might want to educate the community about the impact of overpopulation on the environment. There are a number of topics worthy of in-depth exploration.
