

School Event Video Taping

Directions: With a team, videotape a school athletic event, fine arts performance, or other school activity as assigned by your teacher.

1. Assign roles, responsibilities, and deadlines for each team member. Have your teacher review and approve your assignments.
2. Meet with the sponsor or coach of the school activity to set goals for your videotaping project.
3. Use the Video Tape Shot Sheet to plan your taping.
4. Use the Music Planning Sheet to plan the music you will use for the completed video.
5. Use the Video Tape Editing Sheet to plan editing your raw video footage into a finished video.
6. Your final video should be five to ten minutes in length and must include:
 - ◆ A title with the name of the school activity and year
 - ◆ Photos or video of a team practice or rehearsal of the activity
 - ◆ Photos or video of a match, game, or performance
 - ◆ Individual or group photos of the team or group
 - ◆ The team or group's performance record
 - ◆ Some narration
 - ◆ Some background music
 - ◆ A short interview clip with a key participant, player, sponsor, or coach
7. Present the final video to the sponsor or coach for his or her final approval before you present it to the class.
