- 3. Do not create any sparks when working around gasoline.
- **4.** Connect vehicle system to a vent hose in a closed shop.

- **2.** Hand tools.
- **3.** Flashlight or shop light.
- **4.** Engine diagnostic machine or oscilloscope.
- **5.** Appropriate scanner or test equipment.
