**Customer's Concern:** When I'm driving my car at 45 miles per hour, it seems to be missing when I begin to accelerate to a faster speed.

**Customer Vehicle:** Toyota Camry

# **Possible Causes of This Challenge:**

- 1. Cracked or carbon-tracked ignition coil.
- 2. Defective spark plug cables.
- 3. Excessive spark plug gap or worn or fouled spark plugs.
- **4.** Restriction in fuel line.
- **5.** Needs tune-up.

### **Safety First Practices to Follow:**

- 1. Do not create any sparks when working around gasoline.
- **2.** Connect vehicle's exhaust system to a vent tube in a closed shop.
- **3.** Make sure vehicle is in Park or Neutral and parking brake is set.
- **4.** To prevent electrical shock, do not handle ignition components while engine is running.

## **Tools and Equipment Required:**

- 1. Vehicle service information and hand tools.
- **2.** Engine diagnostic machine or oscilloscope.
- **3.** PCV system tester and a vacuum gauge.
- 4. Digital multimeter.
- 5. Timing light and appropriate scanner or test equipment.
