To view a copy of Forms 940 and 941 and instructions:

- **Step 1:** Go to the <u>www.irs.gov</u> website.
- **Step 2:** Search the IRS site to find information about Form 940 and Form 941.
- Step 3: Print blank Forms 940 and 941.



EXERCISE 6.6: WEB QUEST

When hiring individuals to perform work for a business, it is important to identify the status of the individual as either an employee or independent contractor. For an employee, your business must withhold taxes and provide a W-2. For an independent contractor, your business does not have to withhold taxes. Instead of a W-2, you provide a contractor with a Form 1099-MISC. To learn more about whether a worker is classified for tax purposes as an employee or independent contractor, visit the IRS website.

- **Step 1:** Go to the <u>www.irs.gov</u> website and locate Publication 1779 that provides information about requirements to determine employee or independent contractor status.
- **Step 2: Print** your search results.
