# **IDEA ACADEMIC PORTAL** GETTING STARTED GUIDE FOR PROFESSORS

### **REGISTER ACCOUNT**

Create a new account in the IDEA Academic Portal to start using IDEA in your classroom.

- A. Visit <u>academicportal.casewareanalytics.com</u> and click **Register** to create an account.
- B. Enter the required information, agree to the terms and conditions, and click **Submit**. *Click Add New University/College to add your school if it does not appear in the pre-populated list of American and Canadian schools.*
- C. Await approval email before continuing to the **Create Courses** section. Your registration must be approved before you can create new courses.

## **CREATE COURSES**

Create a course for each class that will use IDEA.

- A. Log into the IDEA Academic Portal at <u>academicportal.casewareanalytics.com</u> and click **Add New Course**.
- B. Enter the required information for the class you are teaching, and click **Create Course**.


If the data to be analyzed includes Asian character sets, choose Unicode for the Encoding field. Otherwise, choose ASCII Encoding.

C. Await approval email before continuing to the Invite Students section.

#### **INVITE STUDENTS**

Create an invite that you can forward to your students, inviting them to create their account.

- A. Log into the IDEA Academic Portal at <u>academicportal.casewareanalytics.com</u>. To create an invite for a course, click the associated **Manage Students** icon.
- B. Click the **Generate Student Invite** button, and then click **Generate**. *The student registration email will be sent to your email address.*
- C. **Forward** the student registration email to your students. *Students will need to register to create their account.*
