

What to know before you take the exam.

BACKGROUND KNOWLEDGE:


- Basic understanding of general accounting principles
- Basic understanding of QuickBooks Online functionality


WHAT TO EXPECT:

- The exam includes 5 sections with a total of 96 multiple choice questions. You must answer 80% or more correctly in each section.
- You have a maximum of 4 attempts per section for the basic certification exam and 5 attempts for the advanced certification exam.
- If you don't pass a section and have to retake it, you'll only re-take the questions you missed.
- The exam takes an average of 2-3 hours to complete in one sitting.

Tips to prepare you for the exam.

- Take the exam for a test drive to gauge where you're at in your QuickBooks knowledge with the practice test.
- Take screenshots of questions or sections that you're unsure about and review them at a later time.
- Launch one of the test sections and answer the questions, but instead
 of submitting, just save your progress. Then check your answers
 against the training materials to see how you are doing before
 you submit.





Tips to help you while taking the exam.

- **Don't worry about the order.** Since the test is broken out in 5 sections, you can take them in any order, anytime.
- Go at your own pace. There is no time limit for the sections and the questions in them. Don't feel rushed or pressured to complete it in one sitting.
- Feeling stuck and need help on a particular module? You have options:
 - 1. Attend one of the live webinars that are divided by test module.
 - 2. Watch a recording of one of the "modularized" webinars.

What to do after certification.

- Create your Find-α-ProAdvisor Profile in the Find-α-ProAdvisor online directory and show prospective small business clients that you are a QuickBooks Online expert.
- Maintain your status. In order to keep your certification, you must take the test every year and stay up to date on accounting principles and QuickBooks Online.
