Key Term	Definition	Page Number
Caption	A display name. A field's column heading in Datasheet View. The text in a label control.	417
Control	An object on a form or report that displays data such as a text box or check box, or a button that lets users control a program	430
Crosstab query	Calculates a sum, average, count, or other type of total for data that is grouped by two fields—one across the top of the datasheet, the other in each row of the datasheet.	425
Data Access Page	Allows users to use databases with a Web browser and to add, change, and view records in a database.	436
Data type	Tells what type of data a field can hold. For instance, a number field can store numbers only.	415
Database template	A sample database used by the database wizard to create a new database.	411
Design View	The view that allows you to change the structure of a database object.	415
Duplicate query	Finds records with the same data in a field.	425
Form View	The view that allows you to view, add, delete, and change data, usually one record at a time.	429
Input mask	Allows users to apply a specific type of format to data entered into a database.	420
Lookup field	Displays input choices from another table so you can enter data by choosing from a list.	418
Page View	Shows how a page will look in a Web browser.	436
Property	A detail about an object, such as the size or default value.	415
Property sheet	A window listing the properties for an object.	416
Referential integrity	Prevents conflicting data between two tables by enforcing a relationship.	422
Relationship	A link between two tables based on a common field.	421
Report preview	Shows how a report will look when printed.	432
Unmatched query	Finds records without matching related data.	425
Value	Data in a field. You might key 16 as the value for the age field.	418
Wizard	A series of dialog boxes that guides you through a task.	411
