

## Keyboard Shortcuts for Internet Browsers

Use the following keyboard commands as shortcuts for quickly moving around Web sites.

| <b>To do this</b>                                    | <b>Press this</b>                 |
|--|-----------------------------------|
| Go to your browser's Home page.                      | ALT+HOME                          |
| Go to the next Web page.                             | ALT+RIGHT<br>ARROW                |
| Go to the previous Web page.                         | ALT+LEFT ARROW<br>or<br>BACKSPACE |
| Scroll continuously up the Web page.                 | UP ARROW                          |
| Scroll continuously down the Web page.               | DOWN ARROW                        |
| Scroll up the Web page in large increments.          | PAGE UP                           |
| Scroll down the Web page in large increments.        | PAGE DOWN                         |
| Move to the top of a Web page.                       | HOME                              |
| Move to the bottom of a Web page.                    | END                               |
| Find a word or phrase on the open Web page.          | CTRL+F                            |
| Refresh the current Web page.                        | F5 or<br>CTRL+R                   |
| Stop downloading a Web page.                         | ESC                               |
| Go to a new Internet location.                       | CTRL+O or<br>CTRL+L               |
| Open a new browser window.                           | CTRL+N                            |
| Print the current Web page or active frame.          | CTRL+P                            |
| Select the text in the Address bar.                  | ALT+D                             |
| Display a list of Web addresses you've typed.        | F4                                |
| Add the current page to your favorites or bookmarks. | CTRL+D                            |
