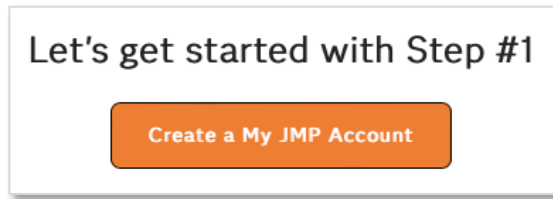
Follow these 6 Steps to get started with JMP

- 1 Create a My JMP Account**
Once you have read through these steps, click on the orange button below to sign up for a My JMP account. To register, please use the e-mail address you use to log in to school's/university's portal.
- 2 Tell us about your Studies**
Now that you have successfully created your My JMP ID, tell us your course name, academic institution, and affiliation. Submit the form to get to the next step.
- 3 Authenticate**
Select your school/university from the list and provide your login credentials as usual. No data will be transmitted, we just receive a notification that your login was successful.
- 4 Checkout**
Given that you were able to authenticate, you are now entitled to order the free JMP Student Subscription. The \$0 product has already been added to your shopping cart. All you need to do is to click the "Checkout" button.
- 5 Complete Checkout**
Continue with the checkout process and provide your shipping address, confirm the subscription agreement, and order your JMP Student Subscription. You're almost there, you just have to click the "Place Order" button!
- 6 Download, Install, and Activate**
By the time you see the order confirmation you will already have an e-mail in your inbox. Be sure to check your spam/junk and quarantine folders, if necessary. Reach out to store@jmp.com if you are still missing out on the order confirmation. Follow the link to download JMP and use the serial number provided in the e-mail to activate JMP.

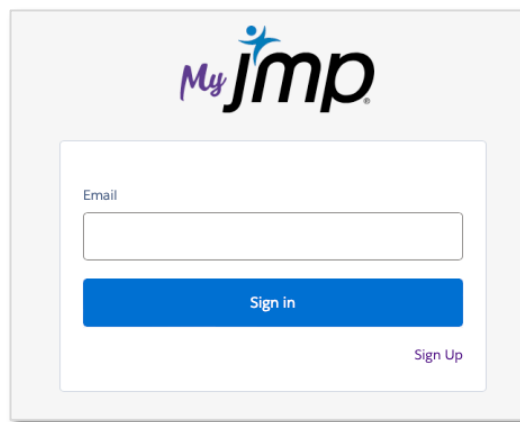

1a. Select to **create a My JMP Account**.

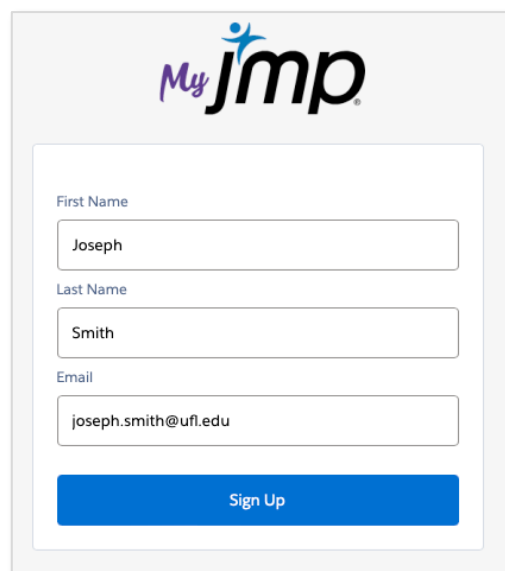


1b. **Choose Sign Up** to create a My JMP account.

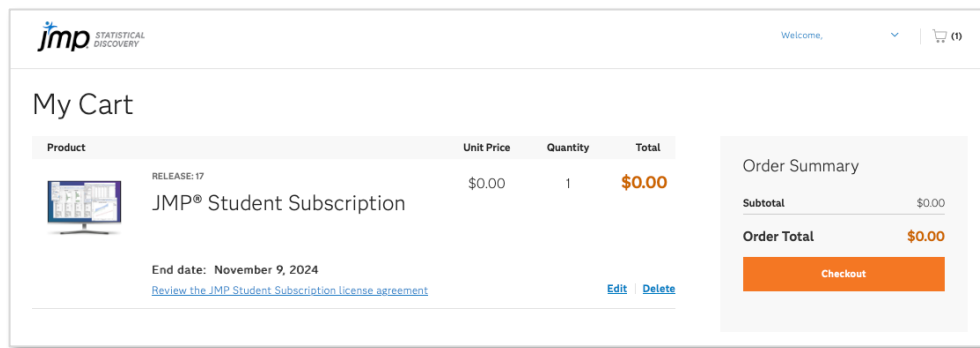

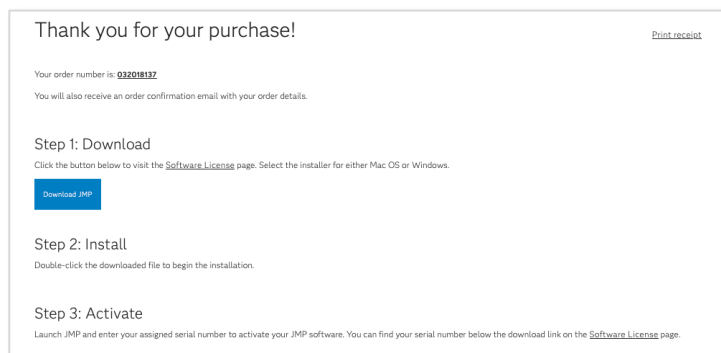

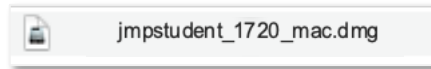


6d. **Double-click the Installer** download onto your computer to launch.

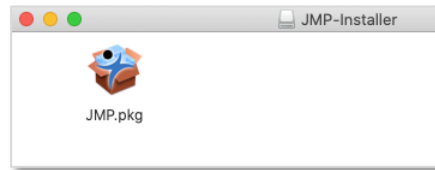
INSTALLING JMP® STUDENT SUBSCRIPTION FOR MAC OPERATING SYSTEM

- MAC 1. The **JMP Installer** will be downloaded to your computer
*Depending upon the speed of your internet connection, this may take a few minutes.
The file will appear in your Downloads folder.*

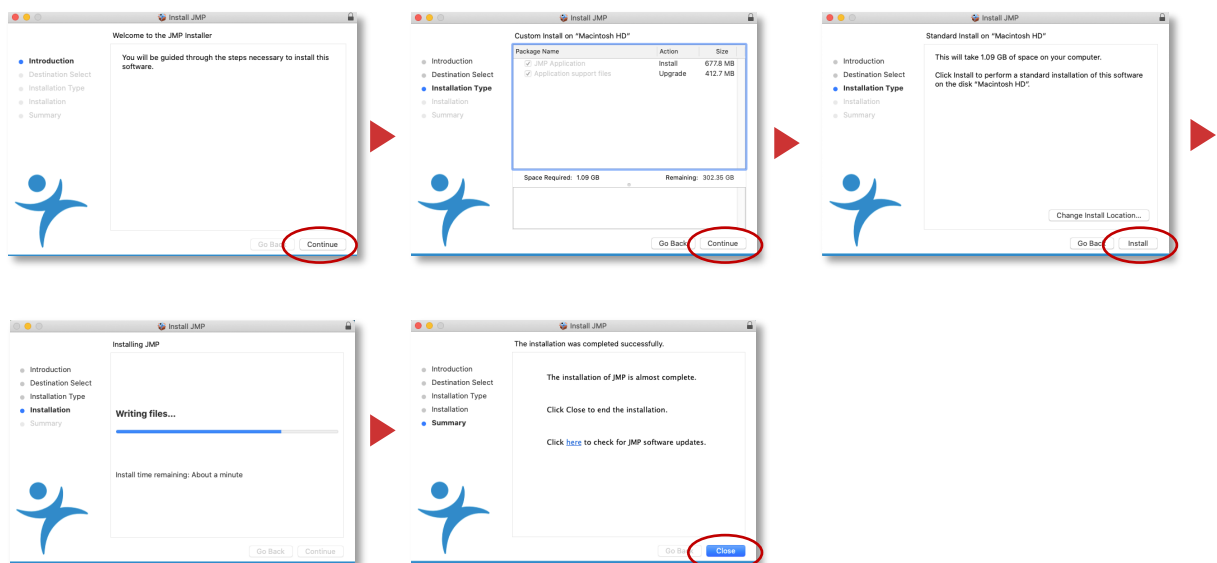


- MAC 2. Open the **JMP Installer** by double-clicking on the file.

- MAC 3. The JMP-Installer window will open. To begin the installation process, double-click on the **JMP.pkg** file.

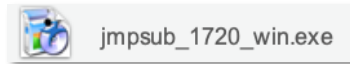


- MAC 4. Follow the steps to install JMP® Student Subscription by selecting **Continue**, **Install**, and then **Close** when completed.

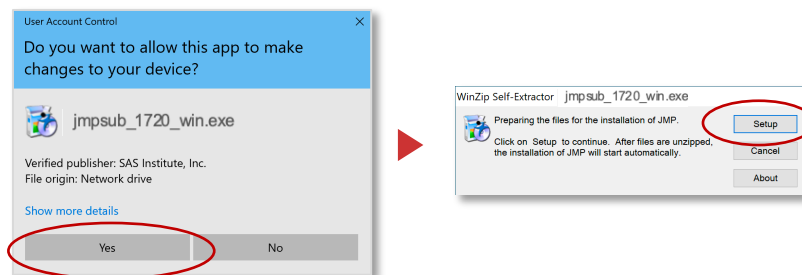


INSTALLING JMP® STUDENT SUBSCRIPTION FOR WINDOWS OPERATING SYSTEM

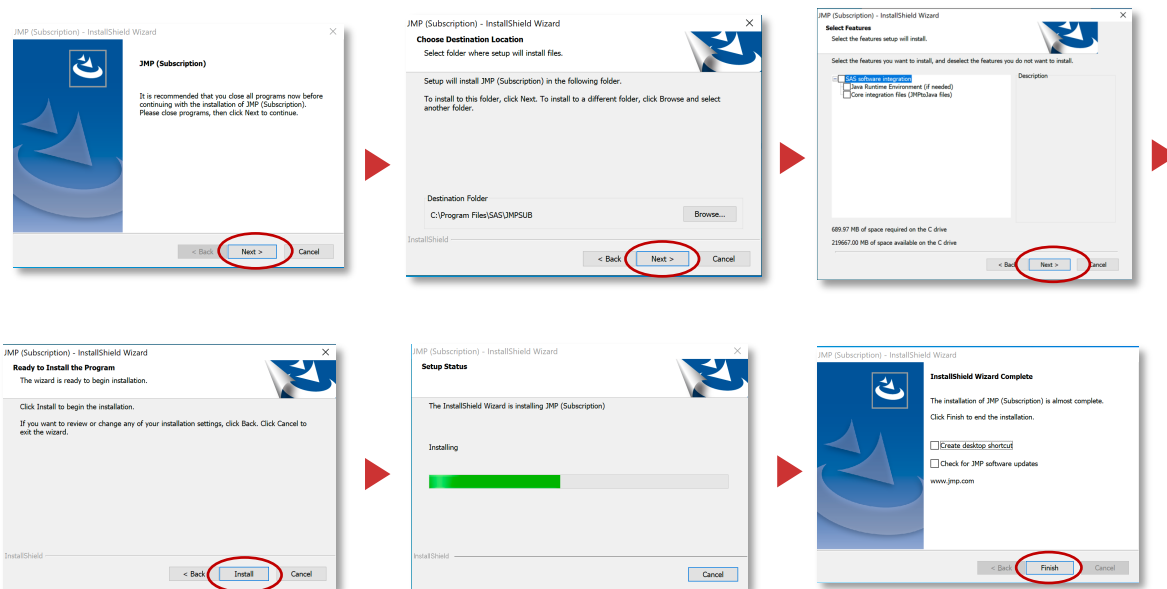
- WIN1. The **JMP Installer** will be downloaded to your computer.
Depending upon the speed of your internet connection, this may take a few minutes.
The file will appear in your Downloads folder.



- WIN2. Open the **JMP Installer** by double-clicking on the file.
- WIN3. To begin the installation process, confirm you wish to allow the app to make changes to your device by clicking **Yes**. Then choose **Setup** to extract the installation files.




- WIN4. Follow the steps to install JMP® Student Subscription by selecting **Next**, **Install** and then **Finish** when completed.



OPENING JMP® STUDENT SUBSCRIPTION

When you launch JMP® for the first time, you'll be prompted to activate by **entering the Serial Number** provided earlier in the process and that you also received via email.
